Treating Childhood Obesity

Blue Cross has partnered with the Alliance for a Healthier Generation to increase awareness about a benefit for children ages 3-18 who are diagnosed as obese (*under an eligible policy*).

Wellness visit limitations at no out-of-pocket cost to the member:

Network Registered Dietitian	1 visit per benefit period** (<i>regardless of diagnosis</i>)
Network Provider	52 visits per lifetime**

Treating Adult Obesity

Blue Cross covers treatment for adults 19 and older who are diagnosed as obese (*beginning January 1, 2019, and as policies renew under an eligible policy*).
